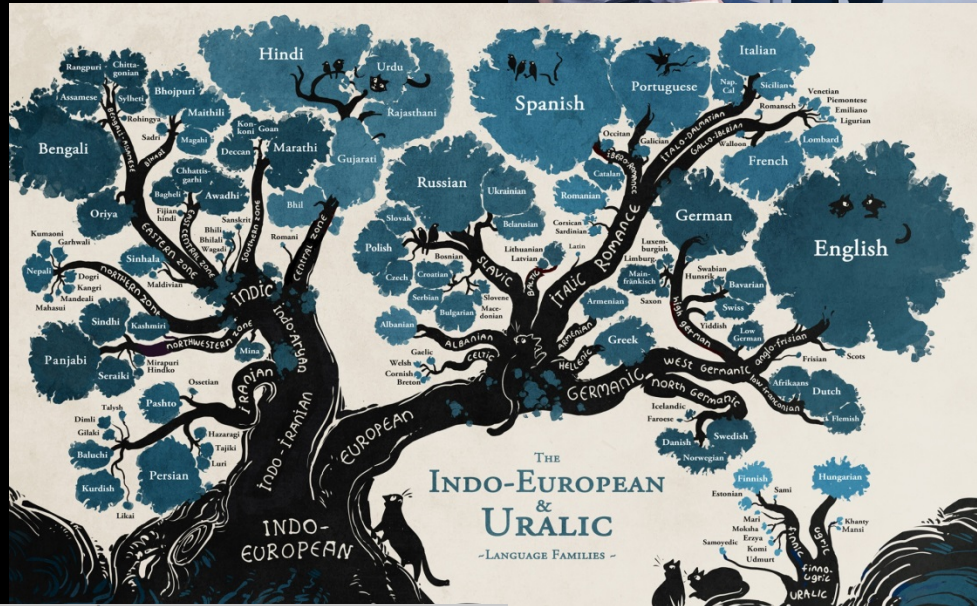


LING-273: Research Methods in Linguistics

corpus_concordance

It is central to corpus annotation and to corpus research . It also has an impact on pedagogical applications of corpora , both for teachers and students.
