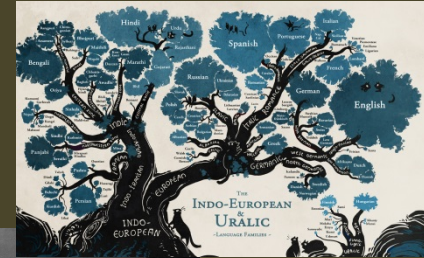


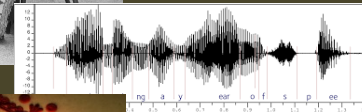
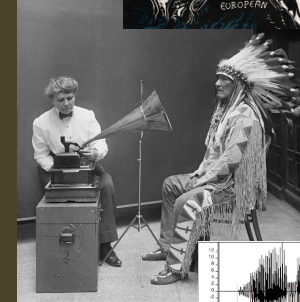
Department of Languages, Linguistics and Literatures



The Department of Languages, Linguistics and Literatures offers a vigorous and cross-disciplinary study of languages, literature, and expressive culture from across the world. Students in our program can study everything from the history of the theatre, to the literature of Japan, to the way language is processed in the human brain. These courses are complemented by language programs in Arabic, Chinese, French, and Spanish. By studying at the programs offered by LLL department students will gain a nuanced understanding of the intricacies of poetry, literature, and culture and will become critical and creative writers.

Since Fall 2016, the LLL Department also offers concentration in Linguistics, which will allow students to gain an understanding of:

- how people use language & how the human mind functions linguistically;
- how language data can be collected and analyzed;
- how people acquire their first and how they learn foreign languages;
- how language is used in different social contexts and different regions;
- what people think about language, its structure and its nature;
- how languages can be scientifically studied.
