SCHOOL OF SCIENCES AND HUMANITIES Thesis sequence

- Thesis preparation (spring1): select adviser, find topic, produce oral presentation of proposal/pre-proposal. Should include IREC if human subjects research will be anticipated.
- Thesis research (summer): can be flexible depending on needs of project, including research design, data collection, field research. Final product is a literature review and revised written proposal to submit to external.
- MA Thesis I (fall2): flexible depending on needs of project, including data analysis, continued data collection, writing, etc. Final product is a substantive chapter of the thesis.
- MA Thesis II (spring2): final write-up of thesis
